Notice of Proposed Issuance of a Final Permit For a Facility Under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act

The Environmental Improvement Division (EID) of the New Mexico Health and Environment Department proposes to issue a final permit to Rirchem Company, Inc. (RCI), 6133 Edith Blvd., N.E., Albuquerque, NM 87107 for the storage of hazardous waste. The EID permit is to be issued under authority of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act (§ 74-4-1 et seq., NMSA, 1978, as amended 1987). The facility has been assigned EPA identification number NMD002208627.

The proposed permit contains conditions for the temporary storage of hazardous waste for greater than 90 days at the existing facility. RCI is a distributor of organic and inorganic chemicals and they propose to offer a waste management service to their clients, customers and to other transporters. The hazardous wastes will be stored in 55 gallon drums and ultimately shipped to an approved recycling or disposal facility.

The permit conditions for the operation of the facility and the administrative records may be reviewed at either the E.I.D. Central Office library at the Harold Runnels Building, 1190 St. Francis Drive Santa Fe, New Mexico or the Albuquerque Main Public Library at Fifth and Copper, Albuquerque, New Mexico.

All written comments submitted on the decision to issue the permit must be received by September 25, 1987 to be considered.
