Dear Commander Guth:

On February 21, 1994 the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) received Cannon Air Force Base's (CAFBs) correspondence dated February 16, 1994 which included attachments of corrected RCRA Facility Investigation Draft Workplan pages and WCC modification to meeting minutes.

CAFB has incorrectly described the topic of this correspondence as a RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI) Workplan for Landfill No. 5 when, in actuality, the topic of the submittal is a Draft RFI Workplan.

HRMB, in a letter dated July 23, 1993, agreed to a time schedule for reviewing CAFBs RFI document submittals. The schedule does not include a review of the draft RFI Workplan. In this schedule HRMB committed to complete a review of the RFI workplan within 45 calendar days from receipt.

Currently the HRMB has not received from CAFB the RFI Workplan scheduled to be reviewed. Therefore, scheduling review commitments have not been triggered. However, in an attempt to facilitate progress of CAFB's development of a RFI Workplan, HRMB will attempt to conclude review of the Draft RFI Workplan responses submitted on February 16, 1994 by April 15, 1994.
