Dear Mr. Kusmak,

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received the U.S. Air Force (Permittee) Holloman Air Force Base (Facility) *Extension Request For Five E54/M125 Non-CWM Bomblets Within the Approved Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) Interim Holding Facility (IHF) At Site LF029* (Request) on April 10, 2023.

The Request is for an extension to the 90-day hazardous waste storage limit for the bomblets because a determination has not yet been completed by the United States Army Material Assessment Review Board (Board) under the Chemical Weapons Convention Treaty that would allow disposal of the items. The Permittee is requesting a 90-day extension to remain in compliance with the requirements of 40 CFR 262.17 pending the determination by the Board. NMED hereby grants the Permittee's request for a 90-day extension as requested. The waste may be stored for an additional 90 days ending on July 11, 2023.

If it is necessary to treat the bomblets onsite due to the hazards posed by transport and the items do not contain chemical weapons constituents, the Permittee may request an emergency permit to treat the items on site.


