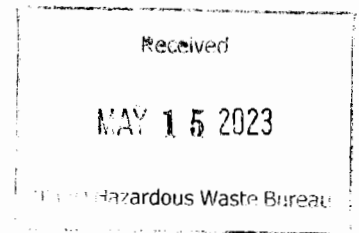

In accordance with Title 40 CFR 270.61, 20.4.1.9000 NMAC, and RCRA Permit # NM6572124422-2 Section I.F.1; Holloman AFB respectfully requests an Emergency Permit to conduct onsite treatment of D003 MEC identified during Holloman AFB LF029 (SWMU 104) site munitions response activities.

The MEC material will be disposed of at LF029 (SWMU 104) using the detonation protocol outlined in the Final Uniform Federal Policy- Quality Assurance Project Plan for Interim Measures at the Former Army Landfill 029 (SWMU 104), dated June 2019 and approved by NMED on October 16, 2019.
