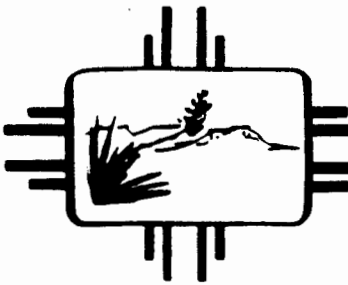

Dear Colonel Brannum:

According to Kirtland Air Force Base's (KAFB) Hazardous Waste Permit, Module I, Section I. 'Documents To Be Submitted Prior To Operation', KAFB was to submit as-built plans of Building 1024 prior to initiating any hazardous waste activities. The as-built plans hand-delivered by KAFB on August 2, 1990 are insufficient. At a minimum, these plans should have included: (1) the dimensions of each storage bay, including depth of depressed floors; (2) stacking arrangements for containers; (3) and the aisle space in each bay. The plans that were submitted did not adequately address items (2), or (3).

You are reminded of the other permit condition to submit certification of construction (Module I, Section E.12).
