The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) in Santa Fe is considering approval of hazardous waste closure plans submitted by Kirtland Air Force Base for the sewage lagoons, golf course main pond and golf course. A base-wide closure plan is also being considered. The plans specify that the units will be decontaminated and their use discontinued. The plans and supporting documents are at the Albuquerque Main Public Library at 501 Copper Ave. NW. The public is invited to review the documents and submit comments. Comments will be accepted until November 14, 1991. A public hearing concerning this matter will be scheduled upon request.
