4. Introduction/Approval of Minutes: Colonel Thomas A. Norris called the meeting to order at 0930. Copies of the Minutes of the meeting held 21 February 1992, dated 16 March 1992 had previously been distributed. Extra copies were provided to attendees at the meeting. Colonel Norris asked if there were any additions or corrections. There were none, therefore the minutes were approved as written.

5. Item #2: Status of the Kirtland AFB RCRA/HSWA Permit. Major Marcia Kurtz, 542d CTW/JA, noted that no update was pertinent as there were no changes since the February meeting. She suggested that this item for future agendas be entitled "Program" rather than "Permit". The attendees concurred.

6. Item #3: Update on DOE RCRA/HSWA Permit.

a. Doctor Herb Grover, NMED/HRMB, briefed the events on the development of the DOE Permit. There have been two fifteen (15) day submission periods for comments and rebuttals since the public hearing. Discussion on the number and list of waste codes and their respective annual estimates of generation followed. There appeared to be some misunderstanding between the annual quantity generation, and the storage capacity of the Hazardous Waste Conforming Storage Facility. At any specific time, the building capacity by type of waste cannot be exceeded. The annual generation numbers are only estimates and are subject to revision for the following year's estimates.

b. Ms Barbara Driscoll, USEPA/Region 6, replied to a question from Ms Ann Newsted, TEMA, that the ~~(DOE Public Relations)~~ plan would be available for review in the early part of June. *Sandra Response to Comments Permit,*

7. Item 4: Update of KAFB IRP.


