Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) submitted a Part B permit application for the Explosive Open Detonation Unit located at the foothills of the Manzano mountains 10 miles south of the city of Albuquerque, New Mexico. On September 27, 1993, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received KAFB's supplemental permit application information in response to the technical Notice of Deficiency of August 25, 1993. The permit application and supplemental information have been reviewed for technical adequacy and found to address the requirements for RCRA permits under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-7).

NMED now has sufficient information to begin preparation of the draft permit. In the course of the next two or three months NMED will be in contact with your office for details of information already submitted to our office.
