Dear Mr. DeWitt:


We have received your letter requesting an extension until February 3, 1995 for the second quarterly Post Closure Ground Water Monitoring (GW) report that was due at the beginning of January, 1995. The report is for the Sewage Lagoons and Golf Course Pond, Kirtland Air Force Base.

We at the New Mexico Environment department (NMED) Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) understand that the report was delayed due to problems you encountered during contract modifications. We also understand that you plan to begin the third round of Ground Water sampling at the Sewage Lagoons and Golf Course during the week of January 30-February 3, 1995.

Based on the above explanation and your plans to continue the ground water sampling HRMB hereby grants you the requested extension to February 3, 1995. We must therefore receive the subject report from you **not later than February 3, 1995.**
