Dear Mr. Darr:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) received the U.S. Department of the Air Force, Kirtland Air Force Base's request for Class I Open Burn Permit Modification. You indicated in your letter of September 22, 1995, that the changes you wished to effect include the following issues:

- (1) Location of the Contingency plan and Operating Records,
- (2) Changes in the Emergency Coordinator List, and
- (3) The use of herculite cover for the Open Burn Container Device.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Fee Regulations (HWFR-1) require the assessment of permit fees for permit modifications. Permit modifications classified as Class I (minor) by the Hazardous Waste Management Regulations may be accomplished with minimum file review and administrative support (HWFR-1, Section 206 § B.1.). The Class I Modification to amend the above items 1 through 3 is subject to a fee of \$1,000.


