Dear Mr. Darr:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) has completed review of the U.S. Department of the Air Force, Kirtland Air Force Base's (KAFB) request for Class I permit Modification. You indicated in your enclosure to your letter of September 22, 1995 the twelve (12) items that you needed to modify. The requested changes were made for the first eleven issues. Item # 12 was removed and will be addressed with the Class 2 Modification requested by KAFB in a letter to HRMB dated January 11, 1996.

Based upon the information which KAFB supplied to HRMB, NMED hereby approves the Class I permit modification for the KAFB Open Burn (OB) Treatment Unit. The effective date of the approval is your date of receipt of this letter. The changes made to the OB operational permit are shown on the first six pages of the attached pages. The second set of six pages, are the corrected portions of the permit text, with the modifications incorporated. These changes have been incorporated into the KAFB Open Burning operational permit text of July 25, 1995, EPA ID #: NM9570024423-OB. You are required to incorporate the enclosed copies of the permit modification into KAFB's copy of the OB Permit originally issued by NMED. Further, KAFB is required to send a notice of the modification to all persons on the enclosed facility mailing list. This notification must be made within 90 calendar days after the change is put into effect in compliance with New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations 20 NMAC 4.1, Subpart IX, 40 CFR §270.42(a)(ii).
