SUBJECT: Landfill B (LF-15), SWMU 6-8, Closure Plan

1. As you requested in our 25 Sep 97 telephone conversation, I am providing information regarding the status of the subject landfill.

2. You received a draft landfill closure plan for landfill LF-15 from the U. S. Army Medical Research and Material Command in Jun 97. This landfill is located on U. S. Air Force land, part of which was leased to the Army. The Army sent NMED the closure plan as a result of the assumption they would have to close LF-15 as required by the New Mexico Solid Waste Regulations (NMSWR) prior to the expiration of their lease and return of the property to the Air Force.


3. This landfill is currently listed as solid waste management unit (SWMU) 6-8 in the corrective action schedule (Module IV) of Kirtland AFB's RCRA Part B Permit. As a result, site characterization and final corrective action is being completed by Kirtland AFB under the Installation Restoration Program and as required under RCRA. For additional information, contact our oversight manager, Mr. Steve Pullen, at the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau.

4. This SWMU, regulated under RCRA, should not be listed as a NMSWR regulated site. We request, therefor, that the site be exempt from the NMSWR.
