SUBJECT: Notification of Discharge Near the Bulk Fuels Facility (BFF), Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB), NM

1. The Environmental Management (EM) Branch of KAFB is submitting written notification of a release in accordance with the New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission Regulations (WQCC), 20.6.2.1203A.(3):

A.(1) On 07 Feb 07 at 1530 hrs, Mr. Mark Holmes, of my staff, provided 24 hour oral notification to Mr. Baird Swanson, NMED GWQB Project Manager of the existing Offloading Rack Fuel Release Site (ST-106) at the BFF.

A.(3) Written notification within one week of discharge (**Due 14 Feb 07**):

(b) Facility: KAFB BFF,

(c) Time, date, location and duration of the discharge: Actual time, date, location and duration of the release is unknown. Time of discovery of the discharge: 0800 hrs, 7 Feb 07, Phase Separated Hydrocarbons (PSH) discovered on the surface of the Regional Aquifer during well development for groundwater monitor well KAFB-1065, installed as part of the Stage 2 Abatement Plan. KAFB-1065 is located approximately 1000 feet to the northeast of the BFF.

(d) Source of the discharge: Unknown.

(e) Description of the discharge: PSH analyzed and determined to be a combination of aviation and JP4 Jet Fuel.


(f) Volume of discharge: Unknown. (approximately 1.5 feet of free product discovered in one monitor well)

(g) Actions taken to mitigate damage from discharge: No action taken to date.

A.(5). EM is investigating possible corrective actions for containing, removing or mitigating the discharge.

A.(6): Mr. Holmes met with Mr. Swanson at the site of the discharge discovery on 9 Feb 07, and has consulted with Mr. Swanson concerning corrective action for the discharge. As required by WQCC, 20.6.2.1203A.(6), a corrective action report will be submitted to you by **22 Feb 07**, 15 days after the date of discovery of the discharge.
