Subject: Drilling at ST-106

Baird

As I had discussed with in September, the drilling schedule at ST-106 was delayed due to the unavailability of the drilling contractor, because of problems encountered on another project in another state. While I was off last week, the drilling contractor completed the problematic project and is currently on site at the Bulk Fuels Facility. We are setting up on the first location, KAFB-1066 as proposed in the S2AP Modification and discussed with



you in our meeting last month. Upon completion of the well installation, as agreed upon in our meeting and in compliance with stipulations you stated would be outlined in the NMED S2AP Modification approval letter, we will coordinate the locations of all groundwater monitor wells with you prior to installation.

On that note, as I have related to you, we have received funding for the next phase of investigation at the East Side of the BFF, which will be integrated with the PSH drilling. As stated in the S2AP Modification, we proposed to submit a letter workplan for the East Side investigation, which we are proposing to complete and submit this week. We would request that you review the brief workplan as soon as possible as we would recommend moving to the East Side location after completion of KAFB-1066 in approximately 1-2 weeks. Of course, the exact nature of the investigation at the East Side will be dependent upon what is discovered in KAFB-1066 as will be outlined in the workplan and discussed with you prior to moving to the East Side.

I will call to discuss, and please call if you want to watch the drill bit turn.
