The geophysical survey of the subsurface offloading rack will be conducted on 18 and 19 Mar 09. This was one of the items required in the 29 Jul 08 NMED memo to ensure that all potential connections and possible points of release have been identified. I believe you have a copy of the workplan.

Additionally, the second interim SVE system for the PSH was delivered this week and installed on KAFB-1068 as we had planned. For the time being, the installation is temporary to determine if the location will prove to be sustainable. If you are interested in a tour let me know. The third new SVE unit is being manufactured and will be delivered in approximately 3-4 months.
