At our last meeting we had a discussion concerning shutdown period for SVE units prior to LNAPL sampling. Shaw determined that one week provided adequate time to collect a proper sample without interference from the SVE systems. Shaw believes this also is the best time to perform bail down testing. Shaw would like to do this on all three watertable wells with SVE units. The shutdown could happen concurrently or one at a time - depending on NMED's preference. Since KAFB 1068 is down for engine replacement this is probably an optimum time to perform this work. I'm sending this email request, as we agreed at the meeting.
