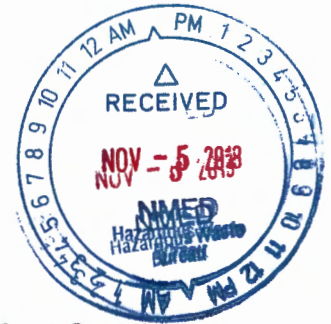

Pursuant to the provisions of the Defense Environmental Restoration Program (10 USC Chapter 160, *Environmental Restoration*) (DERP), Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) has conducted preliminary assessments and site inspections of the Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) sites within the boundary of the installation.

KAFB's restoration personnel have recently completed the Record of Decision (ROD) for the MMRP site AL120 Proximity Fuze Range Munitions Response Site (MRS). As required by 10 USC §2710(c)(2), E.O. 12580, E.O. 13016 and Office of Solid Waste and Emergency Response Directive 9200.3-60, the Air Force is submitting the ROD for MMRP site AL120 for review, comment, and records retention. The Air Force has addressed this document to you, Mr. Atkins, at the request of the Superfund Director, Mr. Carl Edlund. Mr. Edlund said that his office would be expecting this report and that they are willing to conduct the necessary review. The Air Force is grateful for EPA's interest and we look forward to EPA's response.
