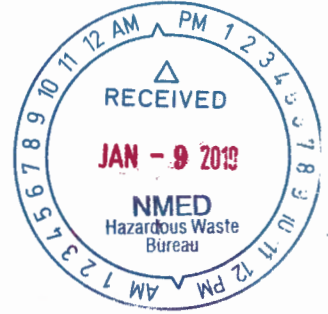

Pursuant to the provisions of the Defense Environmental Restoration Program (10 USC Chapter 160, *Environmental Restoration*) (DERP), Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) has conducted preliminary assessments and site inspections of the Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) sites within the boundary of the installation.

KAFB's restoration personnel have recently completed the revisions to the Proposed Plan (PP) for Remedial Action (RA) at MMRP Site PT123 Tijeras Small Arms Range Munitions Response Site (MRS). As required by 10 USC §2710(c)(2), E.O. 12580, E.O. 13016 and Office of Solid Waste and Emergency Response Directive 9200.3-60, this PP for MMRP Site PT123 is being submitted for your review, comment, and records retention. This document was revised in response to comments sent on 6 August 2018 in an email from Mr. Gregory Lyssy, a Senior Project Manager with the RCRA Corrective Action (6MM-RC) branch of the EPA in Dallas, Texas.

As we continue to implement the provisions of DERP and the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act to complete the identification, investigation and cleanup of contamination within KAFB, we look forward to your input on accomplishing these goals.
