The RCRA Permits Management Program (RPMP) of the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) has reviewed for administrative completeness the above-referenced Application, dated March, 1998, as required under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations.

The RPMP has determined the Application to be administratively complete.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act, NMSA §74-4, and pursuant regulations, at 20 NMSA 4.2, require the assessment of a permit application fee when a permit application is determined to be administratively complete. The fee for the Person Generating Station Post-Closure Care Permit is \$50,000. The calculation of the fee amount is explained in the enclosed Permit Fee Worksheet.

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The permit application fee must be paid within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter. Review of the Application for technical completeness will begin upon RPMP receipt of the fee payment. Failure to pay the assessed fee by the due date may result in the issuance of a Notice of Violation and/or denial of the Application.

Submit the fee in the form of a check payable to "NMED Hazardous Waste Permit Fees." Submit the check by certified mail addressed to Ms. Chika Ezeanyim at the above address.
