Dear Concerned Citizen:

Enclosed is a fact sheet regarding a proposed closure plan that the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) proposes to approve for Safety Kleen Service Center in Albuquerque for final closure of its hazardous waste underground storage tank (UST) system. The UST system is inactive and is presently under interim status requirements of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-7), Part VI, Section 40 CFR 265 granted to facilities that were in operation on the effective date of the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act regulations.

Copies of the proposed closure plan are available for review at the offices of the NMED Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau, 525 Camino de los Marquez, P.O. Box 26110, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502, and at the Albuquerque Main Public Library, 501 Copper Avenue, N.W., Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102. If you wish to make any comments or request a hearing on this proposed closure plan, the comments or requests must be in writing and be received by the NMED Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau at the address mentioned above, by April 26, 1993. Requests for a public hearing must state the requestor's name and address, and must state the nature of the issues to be raised in the public hearing, if held.
