Re: Schedule for Testing and Replacing Monitoring Well MW-71


Enclosed is a schedule for Testing and Replacing Monitoring Well MW-71. Note that the schedule for the testing begins on June 4, 2001, because we anticipate

being busy with the construction of the source containment system air stripper building until that time. We obtained the building permit from the City of Albuquerque for the air stripper building yesterday. Construction started today and we believe that the intense activities associated with the construction will have subsided by June 4. If we have unanticipated problems associated with the construction of the air stripper building, the attached schedule could slip a couple of weeks.

I am providing this schedule on behalf of Sparton Technology, Inc.
