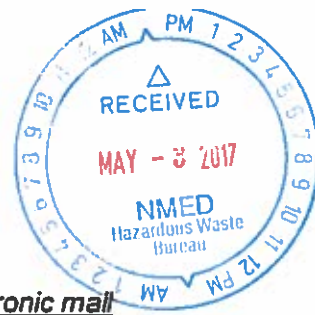

Transwestern Pipeline Company, LLC (Transwestern) is hereby providing notice that the Soil Vapor Extraction (SVE) remediation system at Transwestern Compressor Station No. 9 (the "Site") is expected to be inactive for a period greater than 48 hours. Transwestern's 24" main natural gas transmission line is currently undergoing maintenance near the Site. During these maintenance activities, the natural gas supply line that fuels the Site's thermal oxidizers is shut in for safety purposes. The SVE system will remain deactivated until the lines are placed back into service and the thermal oxidizers are operational.
