
Dear Ms. Boultinghouse:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the *Notice of Revisions to Operation and Maintenance (O&M) and Monitoring Plan, Roswell Compressor Station No.9* (Notice), dated March 17, 2017 submitted by Transwestern Pipeline Company, LLC (Respondent). While NMED concurs with the proposed recovery system evaluation that includes discontinuation of pumping from recovery wells MPE-7, MPE-8 and MPE-9, the proposed change must be presented in the annual update to the O&M Plan in accordance with Section IV.A of the March 2013 Stipulated Final Order. Proposed changes to the O&M Plan must be approved by both NMED and the New Mexico Energy, Mineral and Natural Resources Department Oil Conservation Division. Please note the NMED does not concur with the proposed change to monitoring frequency at this time.
