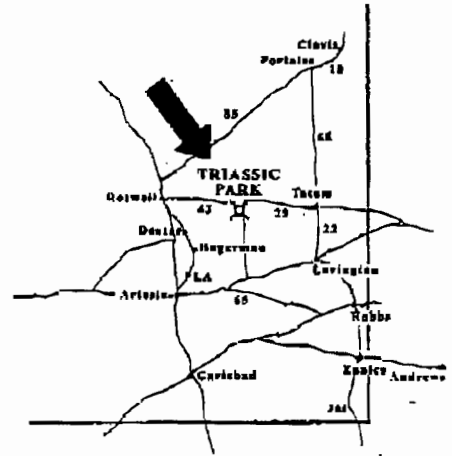


# CAUTION

**HOW?**

- With 491 different compounds: leads, mercuries, arsenics, strychnines, benzenes, TCEs, DDT and many other very toxic wastes.
- Up to 42,000 tons of each of these 491 compounds every year it is open (estimated 25 years or more).
- 5.2 million gallon capacity evaporation ponds will release toxic chemicals that have been found in rainwater and remain hazardous in the air.
- Many of these chemicals have been linked to cancers, birth defects, & other health issues.
- Up to 5 truckloads per hour of hazardous waste.
- 50,000 gallons of water a day, most to be used for control dust.
- Another company currently operates a low-level **RADIOACTIVE** dump in Texas near Eunice and wants to expand into New Mexico. Where will it end?
