Dear Mr. Zappe:

Westinghouse Government Services, teamed with Washington Demilitarization Company, is currently preparing a response to the Non-Stockpile Chemical Materiel Program Solicitation DAA099R0090 issued by the US Army Chemical Demilitarization Program. The Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) was selected as a key project to be presented in our Past Performance Volume of this proposal.

In this subject proposal, we have featured a number of specific achievements, awards, and other notable items to help demonstrate our dedication to total quality and excellence in the performance of our support of the DOE's mission to safely and permanently dispose of transuranic radioactive waste. In the area of safety and health, for example, we discuss our achievement as the first nuclear facility within the DOE complex to obtain both the prestigious Voluntary Protection Plan (VPP) Award, and then subsequently to be awarded the Integrated Safety Management System (ISMS) Certification. Other examples relate to overall business management functions, where the Waste Isolation Division (WID) continues to successfully establish new performance standards by consistently exceeding the established expectations for the performance of business management activities.

We feel that of all the accomplishments and achievements mentioned in the proposal, perhaps the most important one is our part in helping to accomplish the DOE's mission to open the WIPP facility for operation and begin providing safe and secure permanent disposition of transuranic waste. We recognize that this would not have been possible had we not been in a viable, dynamic partnership with the DOE for an initial 5-year contract followed by two 5-year extension periods. Many hurdles and delays over several years were overcome with persistence and teaming, while maintaining excellence in operations, culminating in opening WIPP in March 1999. Presently, the streamlining of permitting and operations to fill the pipeline is underway with this DOE-Contractor Team. Our relationship of mutual trust and respect between the DOE and the WID has created a synergistic energy that in turn has resulted in a WIPP team that continues to grow better and stronger.

In the next few months, the Government's Performance Risk Assessment Group (PRAG) may contact you to discuss the WID's past performance on the WIPP Management and Operating (M&O) contract. The PRAG will be evaluating key indicators of performance risk, including customer satisfaction, quality, timeliness or schedule control, program management and systems integration, cost control, small business goal attainment and compliance record (environmental, safety, and security). You may also receive a project questionnaire.
