Action Items generated at 76th WIPP Quarterly Meeting include:

- 76-2) DOE CBFO to arrange for additional time between audits. The audit schedule is compressed and thus excessively reduces time in the office to write up audits and accomplish other office (non-DOE/ WIPP) assignments.
