Jody:

This is in response to the telephone message you left me on May 15 regarding our meeting at WIPP on April 17. You said in the message that you would not be back in the office until May 21; therefore, here is my response. The only information that I have requested informally in the past and that I'm still waiting from the Permittees regarding previously submitted reports are the following:

1) WLMP:

- The water level summary spreadsheet for all wells is missing from our monthly report dated April 26, 2001 (typically found as page 3 or 4 in the reports)
- Electronic copy of water level measurements for the entire calendar year 2001. We already have a copy of measurements taken for 2000 and earlier.

2) DMP:

- NMED's Round #11 semi-annual monitoring report did not contain some re-analysis reports from the laboratory. Specifically, we need the laboratory reports supporting the concentrations shown in Table 3 for Ca, Mg, and Na at WQSP-3 (sample and duplicate analyses)
- The Tn outlier table included in the Permittees' October 26, 2001 response letter to NMED needs to be revised. The table addressed NMED's Comment #10 and contained the historical concentration of potassium detected in WQSP-1. However, the table does not show the potassium result for Round #6 of 467 mg/l, which should be part of the 19 observation values used to calculate Tn. If this value is added to the table and the duplicate result for Round #11 (823 mg/l) is used as stated by the Permittees, the Tn value of 2.4 calculated by Permittees can be confirmed by NMED.
- When available, NMED requests electronic copies for the last two semi-annual monitoring reports, Round #12 and 13.
