#### Cause of Release

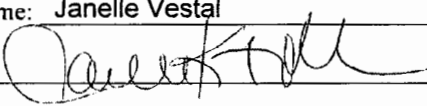

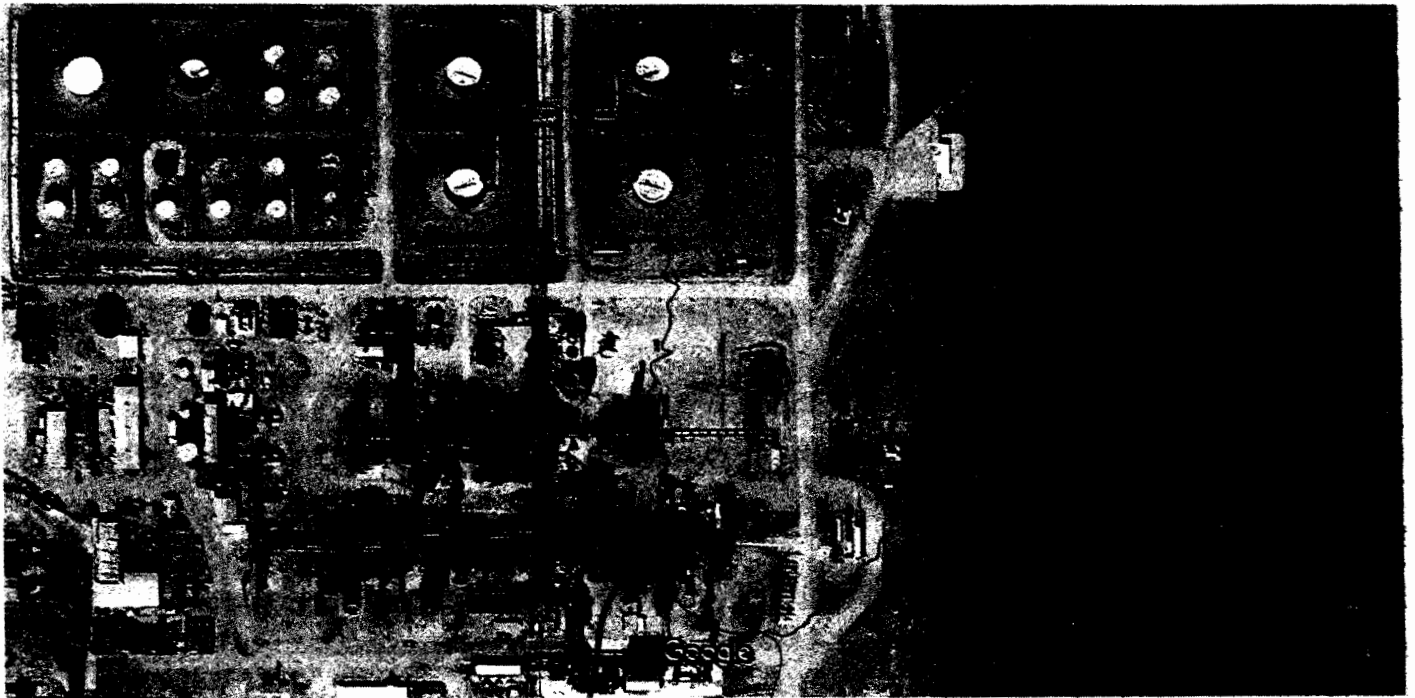
