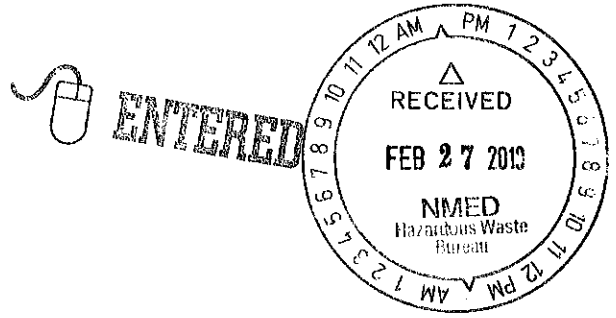

Dear Ms. VanHorn,

The Gallup Refinery is submitting the following request to store a hazardous waste stream beyond its 90-day allowable accumulation time. The waste stream consists of soil cleanup materials from the Tank 563 overflow of gasoline. This waste soil carries the EPA Waste Code of D018 (Benzene).

Shipping of the waste soils was scheduled to be completed before the end of this month. However, the significant snow we received in the past week has made the road to the soil bins impassable by large trucks. Additionally, a large snow storm is forecasted for this weekend, which will likely keep the area wet for much longer.

The Gallup Refinery makes every effort to comply with the 90-day accumulation time frame, but due to this weather, we are requesting an extension of the 90-day deadline. We are requesting to extend the waste transport deadline to 5/31/2019. If you have any questions, or would like to discuss this, please feel free to contact me via email or phone (505-722-0205).
