
The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the Marathon Petroleum Company LP dba Western Refining Southwest Inc., Gallup Refinery (the Permittee) extension request letter (Request) for the *Revised 2017 Annual Groundwater Monitoring Report*, dated May 23, 2019 and received May 28, 2019. NMED's March 21, 2019 Disapproval requires submittal of the revised report by May 7, 2019. This Request was not submitted prior to the due date. The Permittee must submit extension requests prior to submittal due dates. The Permittee requests to extend the due date for submittal of the revised report until June 28, 2019.

RCRA Permit Section I.J.12 states, "[t]he Permittee may seek an extension of time in which to perform a requirement of this Permit, for good cause, by sending a written request for extension of time and proposed revised schedule to the NMED." The Permittee requests an extension to "complete the necessary revisions." NMED hereby grants the requested extension. The revised report must be submitted to NMED no later than **June 28, 2019**.
